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Understanding and Intervening in Child Neglect An ONLINE TRAINING



Child welfare social workers and supervisors employed by North Carolina county DSS agencies are encouraged to take this interactive, self-paced online course. The course helps participants understand neglect, its effects on children and families, and innovative interventions. Offered by the NC Division of Social Services, in partnership with the UNC-Chapel Hill School of Social Work.

10 Contact Hours. Counts toward the annual 24-hour continuing education requirement for NC child welfare staff.

Course Components:

1. Self-Paced Online Session. Participants have two weeks to complete this session.

2. Online Discussion Forum. As part of the self-paced session, participants must interact through an online discussion forum, reflecting on their learning and exploring how they will apply it to their practice.

3. Knowledge Assessment. Participants take a Knowledge Assessment at the end of the course.
